✦ Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Delhi to Manali | Overnight Volvo (6,700 ft | 540 km | 14–15 hrs)

Begin your Himalayan journey by boarding a comfortable Volvo bus from Delhi (post 5 PM). Sit back and relax as you travel overnight, witnessing a gradual transition from bustling plains to serene mountain landscapes.

Day 02: Arrival in Manali | Acclimatization Day (6,700 ft)

Arrive in Manali and check into your pre-booked hotel or camp. Take the day to rest and acclimatize to the altitude.

Local sightseeing includes:

- Hadimba Devi Temple – Set amidst lush cedar forests
- Manu Temple – Located along the tranquil Beas River

In the evening, attend a briefing session about the upcoming journey. Enjoy dinner and a relaxed overnight stay.

Day 03: Manali to Jispa (10,498 ft | 110 km | 3–4 hrs)

After breakfast, begin your drive towards Ladakh. Enjoy scenic views as you pass through Solang Valley and traverse the iconic Atal Tunnel.

Reach Jispa and check into Swiss camps. Spend the evening unwinding under a stunning Himalayan night sky. Dinner included.

Day 04: Jispa to Sarchu (14,100 ft | 90 km | 3–4 hrs)

Start early and continue your ascent into the high Himalayas.

Today's highlights:

- Baralacha La Pass (16,043 ft)
- Suraj Taal & Deepak Taal
- Scenic drive along the Chandrabhaga River
- Rugged terrains of Darcha & Zingzing Bar

Arrive at Sarchu, check into camps, and enjoy dinner before resting.

Day 05: Sarchu to Leh (11,562 ft | 250 km | 6–7 hrs)

One of the most thrilling stretches of the journey.

En route:

- Nakee La & Lachulung La Passes
- Whiskey Nallah
- Pang & the vast More Plains
- Tanglang La Pass

Arrive in Leh, check into your hotel, and relax overnight.

Day 06: Leh to Nubra Valley (via Khardung La) (10,000 ft | 160 km | 5–6 hrs)

Ride over Khardung La Pass, one of the world's highest motorable roads.

En route:

- Diskit Monastery
- Giant Maitreya Buddha Statue

At Nubra Valley (Hunder), you may opt for a camel ride in the sand dunes (at own cost). Dinner and overnight stay.

Day 07: Nubra to Turtuk Excursion (Return to Nubra) (9,850 ft | 196 km | 8–9 hrs)

Explore Turtuk Village, located near the Line of Control.

Experience:

- Unique Balti culture
- Scenic views of the Shyok River
- Glimpses towards the K2 region

Return to Nubra for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 08: Nubra to Pangong Lake (14,000 ft | 160 km | 7–8 hrs)

Travel via one of Ladakh's most adventurous routes (Shyok River/Wari La Pass, depending on conditions).

Arrive at the mesmerizing Pangong Tso Lake, known for its ever-changing hues of blue. Enjoy the serene surroundings. Dinner and overnight stay at lakeside camps.

Note: Route may vary depending on weather and road conditions.

Day 09: Pangong to Leh (via Chang La) (11,600 ft | 160 km | 5–6 hrs)

After breakfast, ride back to Leh via Chang La Pass.

En route:

- Druk White Lotus School (popularly known as 3 Idiots School)
- Optional visits to Thiksey & Shey Monasteries

Arrive in Leh, check in, and enjoy dinner.

Day 10: Leh to Kargil (8,780 ft | 240 km | 6–7 hrs)

Drive through stunning landscapes towards Kargil.

Highlights:

- Lamayuru Monastery (Moonland)
- Fotu La Pass
- Drass War Memorial
- Views of Tiger Hill

Overnight stay in Kargil.

Day 11: Kargil to Srinagar (5,200 ft | 220 km | 6–7 hrs)

Continue your journey to Srinagar.

En route:

- Zoji La Pass
- Sonmarg Valley (Mini Switzerland)

Arrive in Srinagar and check into your hotel. Relax after a scenic drive.

Day 12: Departure from Srinagar

After breakfast, check out of the hotel. If time permits, explore Srinagar or enjoy a peaceful moment before your onward journey.

- Fuel expenses and Helmet are covered as per the planned itinerary route.
- All required bike permits and Inner Line Permits are arranged for a hassle-free journey.
- A dedicated luggage support vehicle will be provided. Each traveller can carry one rucksack/duffle bag (up to 60 litres).
- Services of an experienced road captain and professional motorbike mechanic from Day 3 to Day 11 for full on-road support.
- Enjoy a comfortable stay in pre-booked deluxe hotels on triple sharing basis (*double sharing for couples*) at Leh, Kullu Manali, Kargil, and Srinagar.
- Experience unique accommodation in Swiss Camps with attached washrooms on triple sharing (double sharing for couples) at Nubra Valley, Pangong Tso, Jispa, and Sarchu.
- Relish buffet breakfast from Day 3 to Day 12 and buffet dinner from Day 2 to Day 11.
- A basic first-aid medical kit and oxygen cylinder will be carried by the road captain for safety at high altitudes.

Exclusions

- Airfare, train fare, bus station transfers or any transportation not specifically mentioned under inclusions.
- Travel insurance of any kind (medical, accidental, theft, etc.) is not included.
- Cost of spare parts or repairs due to accidental damage to the motorbike while in rider possession.
- Expenses for bike towing, servicing, or maintenance in case of damage during the ride.
- Lunch or any meals not explicitly mentioned in the inclusions.
- Any personal expenses such as telephone usage, laundry, tips, table drinks, etc.
- Entry fees for monuments, monasteries, parking, and sightseeing attractions.
- Any additional costs arising due to unforeseen circumstances such as weather conditions, roadblocks, political issues, vehicle breakdowns, or itinerary changes.
- Expenses due to delays, extended stays, or extra meals beyond the planned itinerary.
- Applicable GST as per Government of India regulations.
- Any service or cost not specifically mentioned under “Inclusions.”

Mandatory Riding Requirements

- A refundable security deposit of ₹10,000 per bike.
- A valid two-wheeler driving license

Important Travel Notes

Check-in Policy

Standard hotel check-in is 12:00 noon. Early check-in is subject to availability.

Minimum Group Requirement

A minimum of 6 riders is required to operate a group.

In case of insufficient bookings, the departure may be cancelled with a full refund of the package amount.

Unforeseen Expenses

Any additional costs due to weather conditions, delays, or unforeseen circumstances (stay, transport, meals) must be borne by the guest.

Itinerary Flexibility

The itinerary is subject to change due to weather, road conditions, flight/train changes, or natural events beyond our control.

Mid-Tour Exit Policy

In case a participant leaves mid-tour, the bike transportation cost to the endpoint will be chargeable.

Riding Requirements

Riders must carry:

- ✓ Valid Two-Wheeler Driving License
- ✓ Government ID Proof
- ✓ Personal riding gear

Luggage Responsibility

Guests are responsible for their belongings.

It is recommended to carry a small daypack for valuables.

Liability

Any damage or accident caused to third-party property/person must be compensated directly by the participant.

Permits for Foreign Nationals

Foreign nationals must pay additional permit charges for restricted areas such as Khardung La and Pangong Tso.

Medical & Safety

A basic first-aid kit and oxygen cylinder will be available.

Guests should carry personal medicines as required.

On-Ground Support

A professional Road Captain will lead the group.

A skilled mechanic with tools and spares will accompany the group (spares used will be chargeable).

Backup & Emergency Support

A backup vehicle will be available for:

Medical emergencies

In case of discomfort, riders can switch to the support vehicle.

Luggage Limit

Only one rucksack/duffle bag (max 60 litres per person) is allowed in the backup vehicle due to limited space.
