✦ Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Arrival in Leh | Rest & Acclimatization (11,600 ft)

Arrive in Leh and transfer to your hotel. After check-in, take the day to relax and acclimatize to the high altitude. In the evening, attend a short briefing session about the journey ahead. Enjoy a warm dinner and overnight stay in Leh.

Day 02: Leh to Nubra Valley (10,000 ft | 160 km | 5–6 hrs)

Start your day with a hearty breakfast before riding towards Nubra Valley, a breathtaking cold desert surrounded by majestic mountains. Cross the iconic Khardung La Pass, one of the highest motorable roads in the world. Upon arrival, you can opt for a camel ride in the sand dunes of Hunder (at additional cost). End your day with dinner and an overnight stay in Nubra Valley.

Day 03: Nubra Valley to Pangong Tso (14,000 ft | 160 km | 7–8 hrs)

After breakfast, gear up for an adventurous ride through rugged terrains towards the stunning Pangong Tso. Travel via the scenic Shyok River route or the adventurous Wari La Pass, depending on road conditions. On arrival, soak in the mesmerizing beauty of the crystal-clear blue lake of Pangong Tso. Enjoy dinner and overnight stay near Pangong Tso.

Day 04: Pangong to Hanle (via Rezang La War Memorial)

Begin your day with breakfast by the lake and ride towards Hanle. En route, visit Chushul and pay homage at the Rezang La War Memorial, honoring the heroes of the 1962 Indo-China War. Ride past dramatic landscapes including the Black Mountain and Loma Bend. If time permits, visit the Hanle Observatory before 4 PM. Enjoy dinner and an unforgettable night under the star-lit sky in Hanle.

Day 05: Hanle to Umling La & Demchok

Prepare for the most thrilling day of your journey. Ride towards Umling La, one of the highest motorable roads in the world, offering unmatched views and an adrenaline-pumping experience. Weather permitting, continue to Demchok Village, a serene settlement near the Indo-China border, a stunning natural border, where you can witness the beautiful India-China river. Return via Loma Bend and head back to Nyoma/Hanle for dinner and overnight stay under the spectacular Himalayan sky.

Day 06: Nyoma/Hanle to Leh (via Chumathang)

After breakfast, begin your return journey to Leh. En route, visit:

Mahe Bridge – a striking engineering marvel.

Chumathang Hot Springs – perfect for a relaxing stop

Thiksey Monastery – known for its stunning architecture and panoramic views

Rancho School – made famous by the movie 3 Idiots

Arrive in Leh by evening. Enjoy your final dinner and a comfortable overnight stay.

Day 07: Leh Local Sightseeing

Start your day with a hearty breakfast and set out on an exciting local sightseeing tour in a comfortable tempo traveller.

Begin with a visit to the serene Pathar Sahib Gurudwara, a peaceful spiritual site known for its tranquil surroundings and divine significance. Continue to the fascinating Magnetic Hill, where you'll experience the unique optical illusion that makes vehicles appear to roll uphill against gravity.

Next, witness one of Ladakh's most stunning natural spectacles — the confluence of the Indus and Zaskar Rivers, where two rivers merge in a striking display of contrasting colors.

Later, visit the iconic Shanti Stupa, a beautiful, white-domed structure offering breathtaking panoramic views of Leh and the surrounding Himalayan ranges — a perfect spot for photography and peaceful reflection.

Enjoy scenic drives along the Leh–Srinagar Highway (NH1), passing army camps and checkpoints that offer a glimpse into the region's strategic importance.

Wrap up your day with a delicious dinner and unwind with a comfortable overnight stay in Leh.

Day 08: Departure from Leh

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your onward journey, taking back unforgettable memories of your adventure across Ladakh.

Inclusions

- Ride on Royal Enfield Himalayan 411CC motorcycles, provided from the morning of Day 2 till the evening of Day 6.
- Fuel expenses and Helmet are covered as per the planned itinerary route.
- All required bike permits and Inner Line Permits are arranged for a hassle-free journey.
- A dedicated luggage support vehicle will be provided. Each traveller can carry one rucksack/duffle bag (up to 60 litres).
- Services of an experienced road captain and professional motorbike mechanic from Day 2 to Day 6 for full on-road support.
- Enjoy a comfortable stay in pre-booked deluxe hotels on triple sharing basis (*double sharing for couples*).
- Experience unique accommodation in Swiss camps with attached washrooms on triple sharing (*double sharing for couples*) at Nubra Valley and Pangong Tso.
- Relish buffet breakfast from Day 2 to Day 8 and buffet dinner from Day 1 to Day 7.
- A basic first-aid medical kit and oxygen cylinder will be carried by the road captain for safety at high altitudes.

Exclusions

- Airfare, train fare, bus station transfers or any transportation not specifically mentioned under inclusions.
- Travel insurance of any kind (medical, accidental, theft, etc.) is not included.
- Cost of spare parts or repairs due to accidental damage to the motorbike while in rider possession.
- Expenses for bike towing, servicing, or maintenance in case of damage during the ride.

- Lunch or any meals not explicitly mentioned in the inclusions.
- Any personal expenses such as telephone usage, laundry, tips, table drinks, etc.
- Entry fees for monuments, monasteries, parking, and sightseeing attractions.
- Any additional costs arising due to unforeseen circumstances such as weather conditions, roadblocks, political issues, vehicle breakdowns, or itinerary changes.
- Expenses due to delays, extended stays, or extra meals beyond the planned itinerary.
- Applicable GST as per Government of India regulations.
- Any service or cost not specifically mentioned under “Inclusions.”

Mandatory Riding Requirements

- A refundable security deposit of ₹10,000 per bike.
- A valid two-wheeler driving license

Important Travel Notes

Check-in Policy

Standard hotel check-in is 12:00 noon. Early check-in is subject to availability.

Minimum Group Requirement

A minimum of 6 riders is required to operate a group.

In case of insufficient bookings, the departure may be cancelled with a full refund of the package amount.

Unforeseen Expenses

Any additional costs due to weather conditions, delays, or unforeseen circumstances (stay, transport, meals) must be borne by the guest.

Itinerary Flexibility

The itinerary is subject to change due to weather, road conditions, flight/train changes, or natural events beyond our control.

Mid-Tour Exit Policy

In case a participant leaves mid-tour, the bike transportation cost to the endpoint will be chargeable.

Riding Requirements

Riders must carry:

- ✓ Valid Two-Wheeler Driving License
- ✓ Government ID Proof
- ✓ Personal riding gear

Luggage Responsibility

Guests are responsible for their belongings.

It is recommended to carry a small daypack for valuables.

Liability

Any damage or accident caused to third-party property/person must be compensated directly by the participant.

Permits for Foreign Nationals

Foreign nationals must pay additional permit charges for restricted areas such as Khardung La and Pangong Tso.

Medical & Safety

A basic first-aid kit and oxygen cylinder will be available.

Guests should carry personal medicines as required.

On-Ground Support

A professional Road Captain will lead the group.

A skilled mechanic with tools and spares will accompany the group (spares used will be chargeable).

Backup & Emergency Support

A backup vehicle will be available for:

Medical emergencies

In case of discomfort, riders can switch to the support vehicle.

Luggage Limit

Only one rucksack/duffle bag (max 60 litres per person) is allowed in the backup vehicle due to limited space.
